Objective and Investment Policy

The Fund is an index-tracking UCITS passively managed. The investment objective the Fund is to track both the upward and the downward evolution of the S&P Euro High Yield Dividend Aristocrats Screened Index (the "Benchmark Index") denominated in Euros (EUR), while minimizing the volatility of the difference between the return of the Fund and the return of the Benchmark Index (the "Tracking Error"). The anticipated level of Tracking Error in normal market conditions is indicated in the prospectus of the Fund. The Benchmark Index is designed to measure the performance of 40 high dividend-yielding and ESG-scoring companies from the S&P Europe BMI Index (the "Parent Index") with an Eurozone country classification. To be eligible in the Benchmark Index, stocks shall satisfy criteria applied in three sequential steps : (i) fundamental criteria, (ii) exclusions based on an ESG score and using a best-in-class approach, and (iii) exclusions based on business activities and United Nations Global Compact. The ESG rating methodology is based on key issues including but not limited to corporate governance, environmental reporting and labor practice indicators. The Index methodology is constructed using a "Best-in-class approach": best ranked companies are selected to construct the Index. "Best-in-class" is an approach where leading or best-performing investments are selected within a universe, industry sector or class. It excludes companies falling behind on an ESG level, particularly on the basis of ESG ratings. Using such Best-in-class approach, the Index follows an extra-financial approach significantly engaging that permits the reduction by at least 20% of the initial investment universe (expressed in number of issuers). Limits of the methodology of the Benchmark Index are described in the prospectus of the Fund through risk factors, such as the market risk linked to controversies and the risks linked to ESG methodologies and to ESG score computation. The ESG score of companies is calculated by an ESG rating agency, using raw data, models and estimates collected/calculated using methods specific to each provider. Due to the lack of standardisation and the uniqueness of each methodology, the information provided may be incomplete. Assessment of sustainability risks is complex and may be based on ESG data which is difficult to obtain, incomplete, estimated, out of date and/or otherwise materially inaccurate. Even when identified, there can be no guarantee that these data will be correctly assessed. S&P's website (<https://us.spindices.com/>) contains more detailed information about the S&P indexes. The Benchmark Index is a net total return index. A net total return index calculates the performance of the Benchmark Index constituents on the basis that any dividends or distributions are included in the Benchmark Index returns after withholding tax retention. The Fund seeks to achieve its objective via a direct replication, by investing primarily in the securities comprising the Benchmark Index. To optimize the Benchmark Index replication, the Fund may use a sampling replication strategy. The potential use of this technique is published on Amundi's website: www.amundiETF.com. Description of the Index

The Index is designed to measure the performance of 40 of the highest dividend-yielding and ESG-scoring companies within the S&P Euro High Yield Dividend Aristocrats index with a Eurozone country classification. The index uses S&P DJI ESG Scores as part of the constituent selection process and applies exclusions based on companies' involvement in specific business activities, performance against the principles of United Nations' Global Compact, and involvement in relevant ESG controversies.

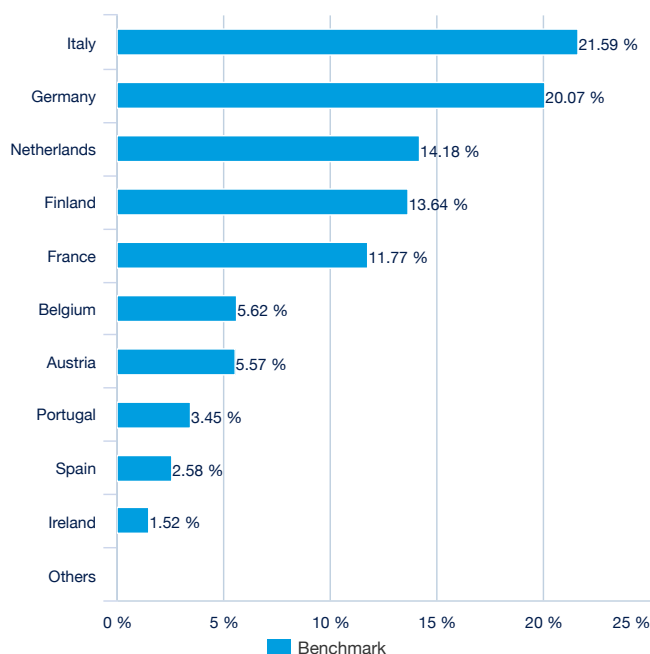

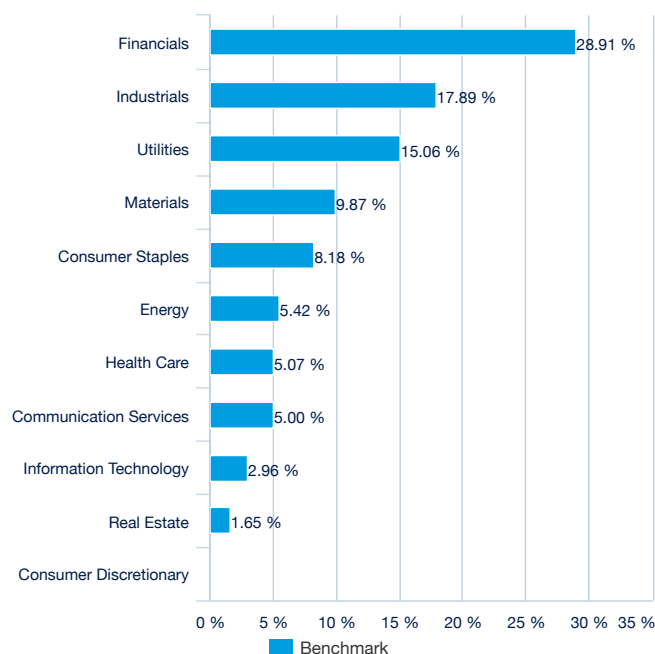
